The institute for Sustainable development is an interdisciplinary research and training unit which was first established at the school of Economic Studies in2006 and reorganized in 2014 by name of Institute for Sustainable. The aim of the institute is to develop and implement research projects with national and international financing, to carry out fundamental and development policy research work. The Institute undertakes activities in 3 directions: research, education and training and provision of services to society.

Research and education activities of the institute focus on the following main topics:

- o Global, regional and local development trends
- o National development strategy, sustainable development policy
- o Environment and development linkage—limits to growth, sustainable use of natural resources, environmentally sustainable economic development
- o International Trade, environment and sustainable development
- o Corporate social responsibility
- o Environmental impact assessment
